September 16	<u>In the Pits (pg. 19)</u> Build a pit using blocks. (use this as illustration when telling the story)	<u>Lesson 1: Let's Get Along</u> Can use tie dye shirt in bin as story aid with block pit	<u>Joseph & his brothers</u> Glue 12 people figures onto a large 11 x 17 paper. Show sad faces on 11 and a happy face on one. Decorate the happy face person with a colorful coat.	<u>Joseph's Coat</u> Decorate a large Joseph's coat for the Bulletin Board with dot markers, stickers, pom poms, sequins, etc.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Blocks * 11 x 17 paper * Cut out people figures * Large coat for BB * Decorative items
September 23 Send home letter about bringing food donation for next week's lesson	<u>Target Toss (pg. 36)</u> – Change book idea and use a hula hoop placed on the floor. Give each child a bean bag to see if they can toss it inside the target. <u>Jail Time</u> – use large cardboard box as a jail. Have kids pretend they are in jail. Can decorate with crayons.	<u>Lesson 2: Helping Hands</u> <u>Lesson 3: Hard Times</u>	<u>"I'll Try My Best" Collage</u> - Glue handprints onto large paper. They choose what things they will "try their best" to do this week and have teacher/aide write it on the handprints. Can decorate collage.	<u>Joseph Says, "I'll try my best."</u> Play just like Simon says. Allow different people to be Joseph (Simon). <u>Book:</u> Alexander & the Horrible, Terrible, No Good, Very Bad Day." September 30	<u>Play dough Food</u> – try to encourage them to make their favorite food out of play dough	<u>Lesson 4: Helping Others Out</u> Intro to story: Guess the number of beans (go around circle & have kids guess how many are in the jar)	<u>Dream Catchers</u> – connect pipe cleaners to make circle. Use pipe cleaners to make criss cross pattern within the circle can add beads (attaching to outside edges)	<u>Food Cart:</u> Walk to the food cart to allow each child to place an item in it. <u>Don't Spill the Beans Game</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Play dough * Plastic tools/rollers * Pipe cleaners * beads * Examples of real dream catchers * Spill the beans game * Extra food for cart

October 14	<u>Bulletin Board Shields</u> – decorate with jewels, tin foil, pom poms, foam stickers, etc. Have one for each service.	<u>Lesson 6: Friends Share</u>	<u>Sharing Shield</u> - cover with tin foil then decorate with name and foam stickers and sequins. Attach handle on back (see example)	<u>Book:</u> “The Rainbow Fish”	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * 2 large BB shields * Individual shields * Handles * Tin foil * Jewels * Foam letters/stickers * Sequins
October 21	<u>Flannel Friends</u> – (preschool)	<u>Lesson 7: Stuck on You</u>	<u>Friends Stick Together</u> – (see example) heart in the middle is them, they choose how many friends to go around. Use tape to connect them.	<u>Stuck Together Song/Game (pg. 84)</u> <u>Teamwork Relay</u> – using a blown up balloon, teams of two holds each others arms and try to cradle the balloon while walking across the room without dropping it.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Black const. paper * Little people cutouts * Red hearts * Rolls of scotch tape * balloons
October 28	<u>Puzzle Problems and Crazy Crayons (pg. 117 & 118)</u> have the puzzles already mixed up at one table and the crayon game at another table.	<u>Lesson 8: Can I Help You?</u>	<u>Helping Hands</u> – use stamp pads to stamp their handprints on multiple cards & write their names. (see example – 1 for each student there) Let them decorate a manila mailing envelope. Hang these on the board and let them put their handprints in each one (like a valentine)	<u>Can I Help You? Game</u> - Just like Mother May I – students ask leader, “can we help you?” leader responds “Yes, take 2 steps forward.”	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Crayons * Bowls for sorting * Puzzles * Lg. stamp pads (preschool) * Index cards * Manila envelopes * Verse/title for envelope
November 4	<u>Memory Games</u> – to help reinforce that even if you can’t see something, you will remember many things about it (where it is, what it looks like, etc.)	<u>Lesson 9: Forever Friends</u>	<u>Make/Design Your Own Stationery</u> – (see example) using stamps, markers, stickers – kids design their own paper, envelopes and holder.	<u>Book:</u> “Franklin Loses a Friend”	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Memory games * Paper * Envelopes * Stamps * Stickers * Markers * Colored const. paper
