## WHAT DO I DO WHEN...?!?

As you walked in, an usher handed you a bulletin. The entire service is printed there so that you can easily follow along with prayers, readings, songs and the service in general.

During the service, you will be periodically invited to stand as you are able (you are not required to). These places are indicated in the bulletin with an \*.

Places that you are invited to join in reading are printed in **bold**.

**Passing the Peace:** This is a way of greeting our fellow church goers. Simply look around and smile and wave at those near you.

**Offering:** If you would like to make an offering (or donation) to KOG, there are several ways to do it. You can place it in the collection plate as you leave, you can give online at [kogaz.org/give](http://kogaz.org/give) or with the QR code on the back of the bulletin.

**Communion:** We take communion every Sunday. As you entered, there was a table set up to pick up communion "kits." They contain both

bread and wine. And, both gluten free wafers and white grape juice are available—just ask!

We practice open communion at King of Glory. That means that if you believe Jesus Christ is your Lord and Savior you are welcome to commune with us.

When directed, please eat the wafer and drink from your individual communion cup. Afterwards, please place this back in the bag provided and dispose of it on your way out.

You don't need to rush. This is time for you and God and we typically have a musical offering to facilitate the time.

That's it—you've made it through your first service! As you leave, please stop in the narthex (see the "where is that?!?" section for a map of the campus; it's the space you entered from) and grab some brochures about us and our ministries and say hello to the pastor if you want. ## WORSHIPING WITH KIDS:

At KOG we encourage children to worship with their families. But we also understand that it can be hard for them to sit still!

We have a nursery space off the welcome center (see the map) that you are welcome to use, but it is not staffed at this time. You can watch the service from the Welcome Center while your child plays, or if you just need a quiet moment with them.

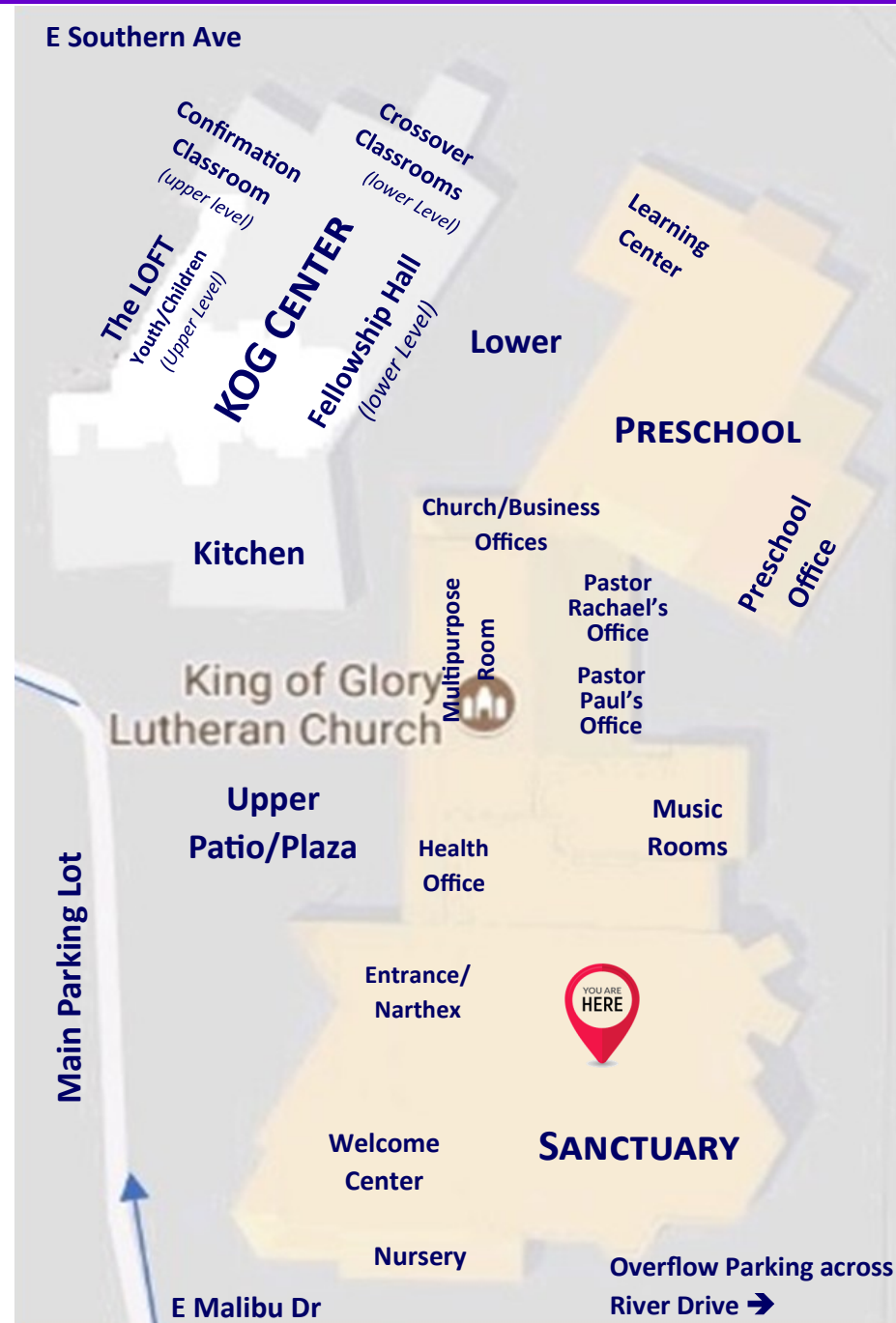
We also have church appropriate activities available for your use where you picked up communion. Just ask an usher and they will be happy to help you.

## HEARING AND VISION ASSISTANCE:

The sanctuary is equipped with telecoil. If you wear hearing aids or have cochlear implants equipped with telecoil, simply turn it on. If you are hard of hearing but do not regularly wear hearing aids, an usher can provide you with a headset. We also have large print bulletins available.
